Students who have previously won the award are welcome to apply, but preference will be given to new applicants.

Application Deadline: April 9, 2024

Award Notification: Late April/early May 2024

Amount: \$1,000.00 (To be awarded May 2024 to student's account)

Eligibility Requirements:

1) Minimum 3.0 GPA

- 2) Minimum 30 credit hours at UGA at time of application; awardee must be currently attending UGA; may be full-time or part-time student
- 3) Demonstrated commitment to a degree program in the Division of Biological Sciences a) Must have declared a major or minor in a Franklin College of Arts and Sciences, Division of Biological Sciences degree program at time of application (BIOL/CBIO/MIBO/PBIO/GENE/BCMB/MARS)
 - b) Must have previously taken, received credit for, or currently be enrolled in BIOL1107 and BIOL1108 at time of application

Application Requirements:

- 1) Personal Essay (500-word limit) addressing the following topics:
 - How you have overcome obstacles such as socioeconomic or educational disadvantages, or other significant challenge(s)
 - o How you have demonstrated leadership through community and/or student activities
- Résumé (limited to 2 pages) Please include: full name, home address (not UGA campus address), UGA email address, 811#
- 3) Letter of Recommendation a letter of support from a professional who can speak to your demonstrated leadership and/or challenges you have overcome that you describe in your essay. This person could be a recent teacher, supervisor, mentor, advisor, or coach.
- 4) Unofficial transcript
